Use Cheaper Flour.

P. Christensen of the Peterson & Pagau Co., which manufactures 50,000 loaves of bread daily, declares the passage of the ordinance will be a severe handicap to model bakeries and would necessitate making use of cheaper flour. The average loaf of bread sold in Omaha for 15 cents, weighs 20 ounces.

It costs the larger bakeries as much to turn out a loaf of bread at 18 ounces as it costs the smaller shops to furnish one of 22 ounces," said Mr. Christensen. The larger bakeries go to larger expense to give quality to their customers and guarantee sanitary conditions. The smaller shops go to less trouble and can give more weight to each loaf, but what their customers gain in quantity they lose in quality."




