Valve Stem Lubrication

As a general thing the valve stems
need no lubrication. If they stick be-
cause of carbon deposits they may
be cleaned by injecting kerosene
into the air valve of the carburetor
while the engine is running. Some
of the kerosene will pass down the
stem and soften and wash off the
carbon. A mixture of one-half kero-
sene and one-half lubricating oil may
be squirted on the valve stems.

Improper Fuel Level

If the fuel in the carburetor is not
at the proper level, it will cause
various reactions. If the level is too
high it will flood the carburetor; if
it is too low it will result in a lean
mixture and difficult starting. For
satisfactory operation it is impor-
tant that the float be adjusted so that
the gasoline level will be about a
thirty-second of an inch below the
outlet of the lowest nozzle.

Lining Up Bearings

In scraping in bearings the first
consideration is the proper mesh of
the timing gears. The front bear-
ing controls the position of the
crank shaft and its gear, conse-
quently it should be fitted and
scraped in first, the other end bear-
ing being lined up with it at the
same time. Then the middle bear-
ings are fitted in line.
