

Two Bald-Headed Eagles

In Battle Above Detroit

Detroit, Mich., April 23.—Although they had the whole United States sky and part of Canada's to fight in, two huge bald-headed eagles battled above the smoke-filled atmosphere above Detroit recently. One is now incarcerated in a home-made eagle cage by Tony Bovicki, the other eagle flew away and probably is telling Miss Eagle what a wonder he is in a fight.

Mr. Bovicki is suffering from numerous scratches inflicted upon his person when he caught the eagle, and his clothing is torn. Bovicki was returning along Martin street in the afternoon when he happened to look up and saw two specks in the sky. Gradually the two objects came closer to earth and Bovicki recognized them as eagles in battle. Lower and lower they circled. One of the birds attempted to swoop upward, struck the peak of a roof, and toppled to the ground, where it was captured by Bovicki after a fierce struggle.

The eagle measures six feet three inches from tip to tip with its wings outstretched. The bald eagle is rarely found outside the far west and Rocky mountain district.

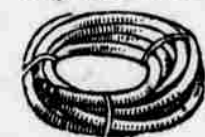

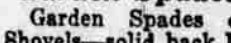
