

Take Subscriptions To Finance Appeal of Confessed Murderer

Pontiac, Mich., May 8.—Anson Rest, convicted last night of the

murder of Vera Schneider, a telephone operator, and sentenced to life imprisonment at Marquette, will not be taken to the northern Michigan prison immediately. A movement to finance an appeal by popular subscription began immediately after the verdict was being continued today. In his statement before sentence

was pronounced, Rest called upon heaven to witness his innocence, and a purse was immediately started. It was said to contain \$1,000 this morning. The prisoner maintained he had never known Miss Schneider and that the confession offered by the prosecution was obtained from him under duress.

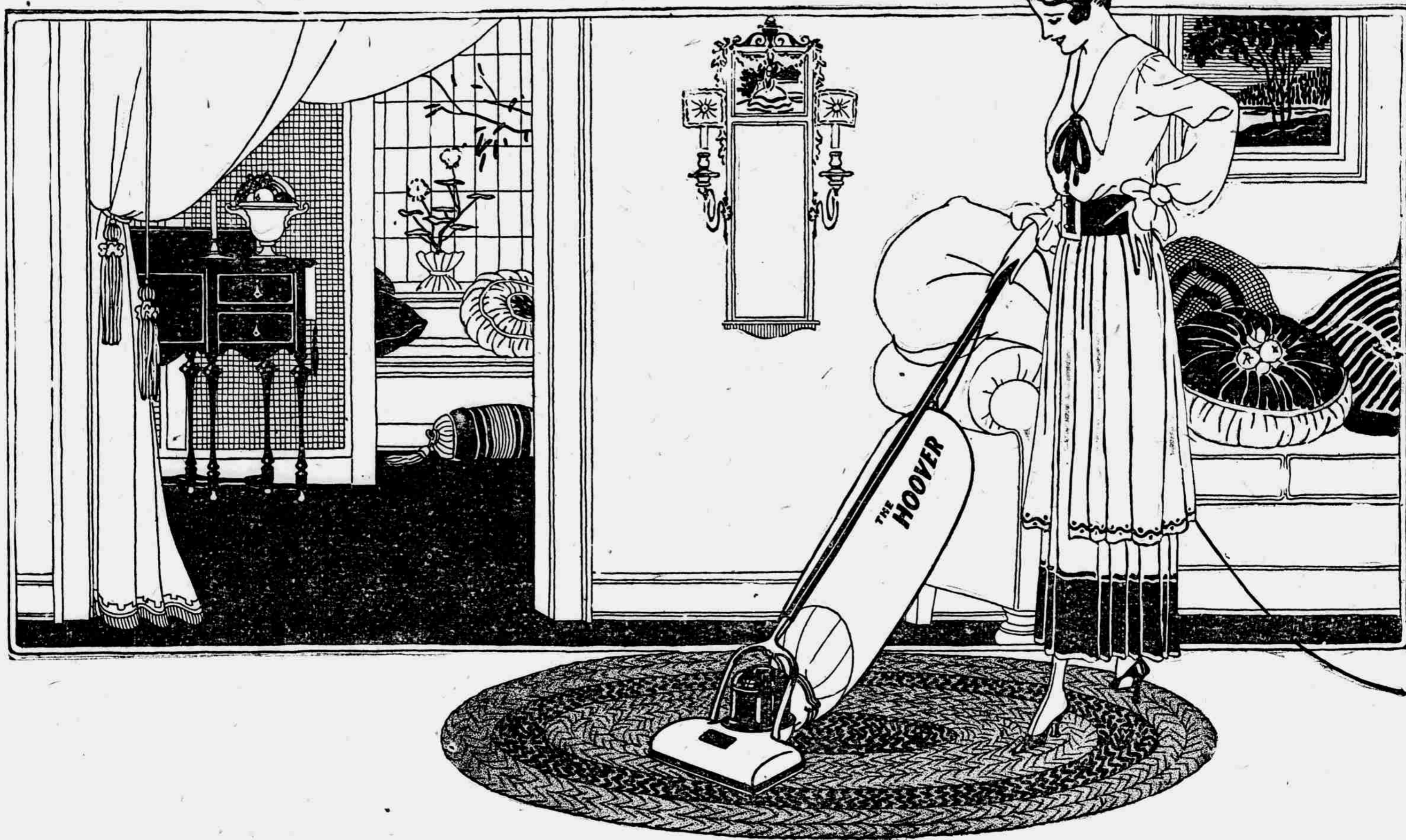
