"While there is in the platform a certain shrewdness in selection of language, there is never any opportunity for doubt as to the true meaning of their provisions relat-ing to labor," they added.

"The republican platform prac-tically ignores the profiteer," the statement added, "and while recognizing the evils of currency inflation, offers no remedy for that condition. Specific proposals submitted by labor for relief from the high cost of living and profiteering are given no place in the platform."

It was at first reported that five men had been caught in the engine room and drowned, but officials at the navy yard said this had not been confirmed and that it was possible some of the missing sailors had been picked up by small craft which aided in the rescue work.


