

ummer drink if well made, and not illowed to stand too long on leaves. An excellent method of making it is to measure six teaspoonfuls of good tea into heated pitcher. Pour over a quart of freshly boiling water, cover, and let stand from five to eight minutes, as it should be stronger than when it is served hot. Strain it on a teaspoonful of whole cloves the flavor is liked, and add a thinly sliced lemon from which the seeds have been removed, or use instead a few sprigs of mint. Sweeten to taste with one-third cupful of syrup stock if desired sweet. A particularly delicious drink for service at little afternoon or evening affairs consists of well-made plain tea, with a lemon water ice, or mint ice in combination. Fill the glasses, which should be tall, half full of the chilled tea, add a heaping tablespoonful of the ice, garnish with a slice of lemon or a sprig of

Crumbs of Bread

A few bread crumbs added to scrambled eggs improve them. Bread crumbs for coating food to be fried is much better tasting than cracker crumbs. Dishes like eggplant, stuffed

peppers or tomatoes, oysters and scalloped salmon are improved when using bread crumbs. Tiny cubes of bread toasted are delicious to serve with either

soup or salad. Browned bread crumbs and cream make an excellent breakfast food.

They make delicious bread puddings and apple betty. They make a satisfactory substitute in bash when you are short of potatoes.

They are indispensable in meat To save work and scattering crumbs fasten a paper bag over the opening in the food chopper with a rubber band when grinding bread crumbs.

Onions for Insomnia

People who suffer from sleeplessess should try the effect of a sandwich of spring onions-bread and butter with finely-chopped onions between-before retiring to rest. These sandwiches are sleep-inviting. Thinly-shaved cucumber and onion. chopped parsley, mint and sorrel are all excellent when spread beween thin slices of buttered bread.
