## RIOTING BREAKS OUT IN IRELAND AFTER RESPIRE

Mob Pillages City Following Assassination Sunday of Inspector Swanzy—Drive On Nationalists.

Belfast, Aug. 23.—Rioting is in progress in Lisburn as a result of the assassination today of Inspector Ewazny. An attempt was made to wreck the shop of a Sinn Fein leader within 40 yards of the scene and only intervention by Ulster volunteers prevented it.

## Pray For Hunger Strikers.

Last night large crowds assembled outside the Cork jail and prayed for the hunger strikers there.

Inspector Swanzy, against whom a verdict of wilful murder was given by a coroner's jury in connection with the assassination of Mayor MacCartain in March, was shot while proceeding to his home from church in Lisburn, to which town he had been transferred after the finding of the coroner's jury. The congregations were leaving all the Protestant churches at the time and converging on the scene of the shooting.

## Fire on Officers.

Captain Woods, commandant of the Lisburn branch of the Ulster volunteers, made a dash for the assassins, although only armed with a stick. The assassins fired at Wood's hand, wounding the stick in Wood's hand. He was not injured.
