## Bolsheviki Make Virtual Prisoners of Delegation-Guards Accompany Members At All Times.

Minsk, Aug. 30.—(Via Moscow.) —(By The Associated Press.)— Members of the Polish peace delegation have been engaged in a contin-ual controversy with bolshevik officials since arriving here. Disagreements between the delegation and the soviet commissaire in command of the quarters where the Poles are -irtual prisoners have reached bewildering proportions regarding the use of a wireless plant by the Poles and the regulations to be observed in the house where the delegates are

Some indication of the treatment in store for the delegates was seen in the action of the bolsheviki when the Poles reached this city. The delegation was escorted by a detachment of mounted soviet troops to a residence near the center of the city about which guards were posted with orders to allow no one to leave ithout a soviet escort.

Censors All Messages.

The correspondent of The Assoclated Press has found it difficult to obtain an exact view of the situation owing to the fact that he is a prisoner, like the rest of the Polish party. A visit was made to a local official, the correspondent being accompanied by a guard, and the official stated that, inasmuch as the correspondent had accompanied the Warsaw delegation to Minsk he was dentified with it. "It is too bad you came with the Poles," he was told.

Seal Wireless Plant.

The Polish delegation set up a wireless plant soon after its arrival but was forced to move it three times in an endeavor to obtain a situation from which it might commu tion was made this morning, and prospects of sending messages to the Polish capital were good, but when an attempt was made to use the apparatus it was found the sovict commandant had sealed it.

Tokio Aug. 30 .- Ikao, Japan's amous summer resort, located in the Ikao mountains west of this city, was swept by fire yesterday and about three-quarters of the town was destroyed.
