

POLISH ENVOYS HECKLED BY RED FORCES AT MINSK

Bolsheviki Make Virtual Prisoners of Delegation—Guards Accompany Members At All Times.

Minsk, Aug. 30.—(Via Moscow.)—(By The Associated Press.)—Members of the Polish peace delegation have been engaged in a continual controversy with bolshevik officials since arriving here. Disagreements between the delegation and the soviet commissaire in command of the quarters where the Poles are virtual prisoners have reached bewildering proportions regarding the use of a wireless plant by the Poles and the regulations to be observed in the house where the delegates are living.

Some indication of the treatment in store for the delegates was seen in the action of the bolshevik when the Poles reached this city. The delegation was escorted by a detachment of mounted soviet troops to a residence near the center of the city, about which guards were posted with orders to allow no one to leave without a soviet escort.

Censors All Messages.
The correspondent of The Associated Press has found it difficult to obtain an exact view of the situation owing to the fact that he is a prisoner, like the rest of the Polish party. A visit was made to a local official, the correspondent being accompanied by a guard, and the official stated that, inasmuch as the correspondent had accompanied the Warsaw delegation to Minsk he was identified with it.

Seal Wireless Plant.
The Polish delegation set up a wireless plant soon after its arrival, but was forced to move it three times in an endeavor to obtain a situation from which it might communicate with Warsaw. The last location was made this morning, and prospects of sending messages to the Polish capital were good, but when an attempt was made to use the apparatus it was found the soviet commandant had sealed it.

The Poles are impatient under the confinement, while the attitude of the bolshevik seems to grow more offensive as news of Polish victories filters through the lines.

Ikao, Famous Japanese Summer Resort, Swept By Disastrous Fire

Tokio Aug. 30.—Ikaio, Japan's famous summer resort, located in the Ikaio mountains west of this city, was swept by fire yesterday and about three-quarters of the town was destroyed. Among the guests at Ikaio were nearly 3,000 people from Tokyo, including many prominent people, who were staying at villas and hotels. Some had narrow escapes, among them being Princess Higashikuni, sister of the emperor, whose husband accompanied the crown prince to France, and who is still in that country. Baron Makino and Marquis Satonji, members of the Japanese delegation at the Versailles peace conference, also escaped in safety. Reports received here state that several persons were injured.

Start Air Mail Service Between U. S. and Cuba Soon

Washington, Aug. 30.—Airplane mail service between the United States and Cuba will be inaugurated this fall, Postmaster General Burleson said. A contract between the

government and Florida West Indies air ways company, calls for daily transportation of mail between Key West and Havana for one year from October 15. First class mail weighing 4 pounds, 6 ounces or less, will be handled, the rate to be 6 cents an ounce.
