

Arrest Bigamist At Third Wedding

Police Nab Man as He Kisses Young Bride, Said to Be His Third One.

Philadelphia, Sept. 15.—As he was kissing his 19-year-old bride, said to be his third one, John H. Glenn, 320 State street, Camden, N. J., was arrested here today, said to be a bigamist.

Plans for his arrest had been made carefully by his wife, who before her marriage at Elkton, Mo., on July 13 last was Miss Dorothea Huntington, a telephone operator in the Land Title building, who lives at 1700 Walnut street. James Sullivan, a detective, who made the arrest, says the prisoner admitted he has two other wives living.

Wife No. 3 says she met Glenn, who served overseas with the 35th motor transportation corps, last April. His ardent courtship resulted in the elopement three months later and they went to live at the bride's apartment until four days ago, when they moved to Camden. The bride continued at her work. Glenn was employed as a brakeman on the West Jersey & Seashore railroad to Atlantic City.

Wife No. 3 had no suspicions of her husband till last Friday, when she was visited by Miss M. F. Cole, an investigator for the bureau of war risk insurance. Miss Cole told her Glenn had been married twice before within a year, once to Miss Stella Stone, a vaudeville actress of Little Rock, Ark., in Louisiana, and the second time to Beatrice Harcourt of Chicago last January.
