

## Murals of the Hall of the Age of Man in the American Museum of Natural History

The great Hall of the Age of Man in the American Museum of Natural History is nearing completion. For the first time the evolutionary stages of human development will be shown surrounded by the gigantic mammals of western Europe and North America, on which the eyes of primitive man first rested as a hunter and as an artist. Here are shown reproductions of all thus far discovered of fossil man, including the famous fragmentary types of the ape-man of Java, of the Heidelberg man and of the Piltdown man, and also the more completely known primitive Neanderthal and relatively modern Cro-Magnon men and women. The latter is the earliest race of artists and sculptors that have teen discovered. The mammals of the five great pointings as yet completed all belong to the same stage in the world's history the last and greatest of the advances of the ice flow during the Glacial Period, when the ice wave passed over the present site of New York City and reached well across Long Island.
