

Delegates Here For League Meet

Plenary Session of International Communications Conference Open at Washington.

Washington, Oct. 8.—Delegates from five of the allied and associated powers met today at the State department in the first preliminary session of the international communications conference. Representatives of France, Great Britain, Italy, Japan and the United States were present.

The program of the main conference and the place and date of meeting also are to be determined at the preliminary sessions which are expected to continue for at least a month.

The American delegates are known to be interested in the final disposition of German cables in the Pacific, as well as the Island of Yap, which with Guam, occupies a strategic position in the Pacific for cable communication. The German transatlantic cable from Emman to New York, said to have been cut by Great Britain in 1914, was expected to be the chief concern of the Americans.

Retirement of press and commercial communication is expected to be an outcome of the conference.

Pilot Passes Montreal
Montreal, Oct. 8.—Colonel Robert Leckie, piloting the seaplane F-3, passed over Montreal shortly before noon today on his transcontinental flight from Halifax to Vancouver. The seaplane circled twice over the aviation station at Longuepoint and then headed for Ottawa.

Gillin, whose resignation as internal revenue agent for the local district was announced Tuesday, according to a wire received yesterday morning by Mr. Gillin from the commissioner of internal revenue in Washington. This information was received in response to a wire sent to Washington by Mr. Gillin, asking for immediate relief to enable him to resign on October 10, as planned, in order to enable him to enter private business.

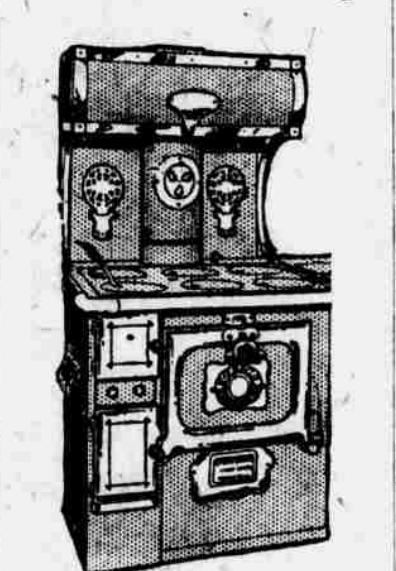

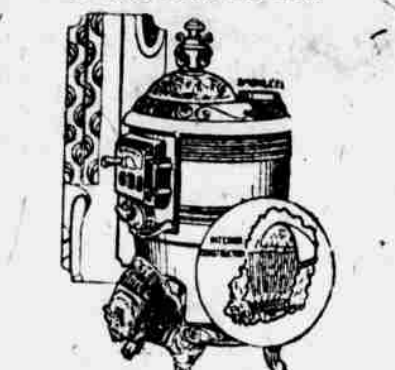

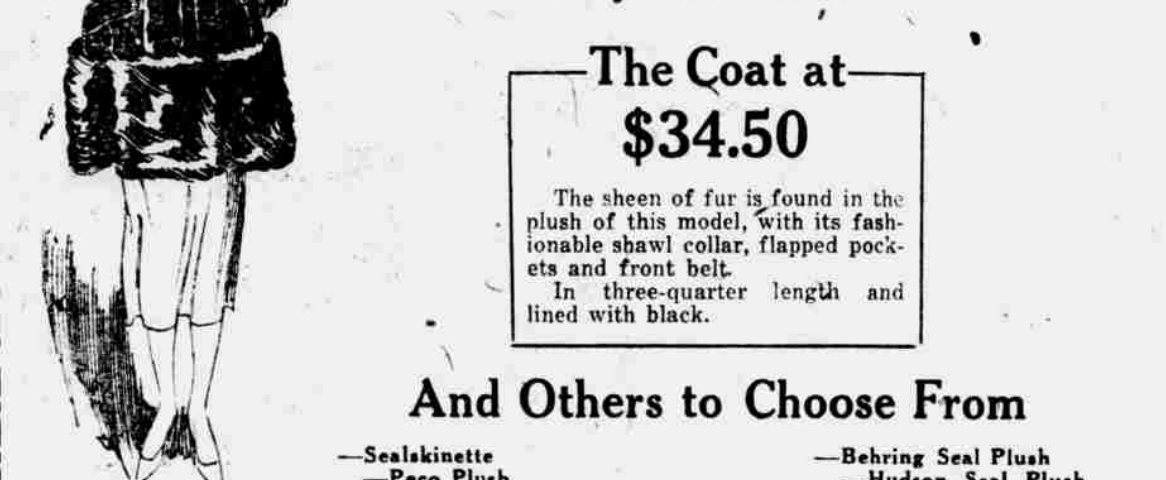
