

**Dungannon Terrified by Reprisals of Armed Men**  
 Dungannon, Ireland, Nov. 1.—This town, located in central Ulster, spent a terrifying night as a result of reprisals following the wounding of a constable during an attack on

a police patrol by civilians yesterday. Policemen, and then armed and disguised men, visited the town and discharged bombs and firearms in many business houses owned by members of the Sinn Fein. A number of places were wrecked and

many families fled to the country for safety. A gain of 55,000 in one year is shown in the membership of the United Textile Workers in Manchester, N. H. The present membership is 105,000.

**Irish Student Executed For Murder of Soldiers**  
 Dublin, Nov. 1.—Keven Barry, a medical student, was executed at Mount Joy prison this morning for taking part in an attack on a mili-

tary escort here during the past summer. Barry was charged with murder, as two British soldiers were killed during the fight. Nearly 1,000 persons prayed outside the prison during the execution. Armored cars guarded the street before the prison. Barry's mother de-

clared last week she was proud her son was "dying for Ireland." Bakers of the Swiss city of Zurich have found they can heat their ovens with electricity produced at a nearby waterfall at much less expense than with wood or coal.

**Man Didn't Mind Time In Jail, But Wanted Music**  
 Sioux City, Ia., Nov. 1.—Jail wasn't so bad, but without his mouth organ William Jackson felt life unendurable. When searched at the police stations his belongings, in-

cluding his prized harmonica, were taken away from him. He was still pleading for it when the barred door was locked behind him. Over 8,000 organized boot and shoe workers in Cincinnati, O., have been refused increased wages.
