Bourgot testified clearly and deliberately. Answering a request by Judge Advocate Major Jesse F. Dyer to identify Lang, if present, the witness rose and pointed across the table at Lang. At this juncture the court retired, subsequently announcing it would give Lang the right to question Bourgot, obtain witnesses

and employ counsel.

Lang, who now is engaged in business in Hinche, started to question Bourgot, but quickly objected to the translator, declaring he wanted a white man. The court granted the request, adjourning Lang's testimony until tomorrow. Lieutenant Colonel Hooker de-


