The New York Times. By ALEXANDER DANA NOYES. Chicago Tribune—Omaha Bee Leased Wire. New York, Nov. 19.—Today was a day of disorder financial and commercial markets.

This early recovery was short-lived; it was followed by a mass of selling orders which brought the day's total business to the highest figure since April 22, when the stock market liquidating movement caused a decline in prices of 10 to 10 points in numerous active stocks.

Liquidation Not Complete. It was pretty well understood by people in the market that the recovery of today's forced selling of stocks reflected the paying of the interest on the bonds which stood more or less in the limelight during the period of extravagant inflation and speculation a year or so ago.

Cotton also fell today to a lower price than any hitherto reached this season, the December delivery closing at 16 1/2 cents. The market was generally quiet, with a few scattered transactions.
