Rent Laws Stop Building

Dg. 0200

C. H. Kelsey, president of the Title and Guarantee Trust Company, on June 21st wrote the following regarding New York rent laws:

"They have evidently scared off contractors and discouraged production of more space, which alone will bring rents down.

"This city has not fully awakened to an understanding of this and conditions are really getting steadily

"Builders will not take the risk of constructing houses if they are denied the prospect of profit for so doing. The old law of supply and demand is still in control and legislation cannot repeal it."
