Reported Extensions Of Union Pacific Are Denied by Officers

Hopes of citizens of Summerfield, Neb., for the purchase of the deserted line of the Kansas City & Northwestern railroad by the Union Pacific system were denied by Paul Rigdon, assistant to Carl P. Gray, president of the Union Pacific.

Gray said that the Union Pacific already has terminal rights in Kansas City superior to those of this line, and our present line between Lincoln and Kansas City, and Marysville, Kan., is in the hands of the Union Pacific.

Rigdon also denied a report from Sioux City that the Union Pacific is contemplating building a connecting link between Norfolk and that city.

He explained that the railroad now running between these points is sufficient to handle all traffic and that it is not the policy of the Interstate Commerce commission to allow existing lines to be paralleled.
