Heated Debate On Provisions Of Coal Measure

Gompers Says Labor Will Oppose Bill Unless Trades Unions Are Excluded From Regulation.

Washington, Feb. 10. — Unless trades unions are "affirmatively and definitely" excluded from the Calder bill for government regulation of the coal industry, organized labor's opposition to it will be unyielding, Samuel Gompers told a senate committee. His statement, together with prolonged and at times heated contest over an allegation by Representative Huddleston, democrat, Alabama, that coal mine operators had indulged in "wholesale looting of the public" and that the National Coal association had something to do with fixing the prices, took up the day. Mr. Huddleston's statement was denied by J. D. A. Morrow, vice president of the coal association, and when the representative said he had a stenographic transcript of directors' meetings in which prices were discussed, Chairman A. Fletcher took issue. He called on W. B. Reed, secretary of the association, to produce original copies of all such records, but was informed all had been destroyed after being summarized in minute books.

President Gompers repeated his general objection to the Sherman legislation, saying that the Sherman act and Lever act for war-time food and fuel control had been turned against labor. Provisions of the Calder bill, "insofar as they may be applied to labor," he said, would be a "step backward."

Company in Europe Aiding Aliens to Enter America. New York, Feb. 10.—Existence in Europe of a company that specializes in aiding aliens to enter this country without complying with immigration regulations was alleged here by five stewards, who left from Havana. Two men, Portuguese, "were shipped" they said, from Portugal to Cuba and reshipped for New York. The men were detained and officials are investigating.
