**More Corn Held On State's Farms Than Ever Before**  
Total of 160,983,000 Bushels Or 63 Per Cent or 1920 Crop Still Remains On Farms.  
Lincoln, March 11.—Sixty-three per cent, or 160,983,000 bushels, of last year's corn crop in Nebraska remains on farms or in reserves, according to the March statement issued today by the federal bureau of crop estimates and the state department of agriculture. So far as is known the farm reserves of corn is larger this year than ever before. Last year the corn reserves supply amounted to 73,674,000 bushels, which was about equal to the 10-year average.
