Merger With Trust Institution Typical of Method of Building Up Financial Houses Now in Progres.

By HOLLAND. On March 8 the number of Na-tional banks in New York was de-creased by one, while on the other hand, an additional state bank came into existence. This new state bank will be merged on April I with a trust institution. The incident illustrates one of the changes which have been a progress for some time in the

banking situation. some years ago banks in New York city began to enlarge their means of mergers with other banks. In that way several banks were built up, from comparatively small institutions until they gained a position of influence and were at last numbered among the most powerful

banks of the country. That, however, was only one development of modern banking. Another now is shown by the action of the Liberty National bank in returning its federal charter and ac-cepting in the place of that a char-ter from the state of New York.

Romantic History. It is a somewhat romantic history which is written by the record of the Liberty National since its orcanization, which was almost coindent in point of time with the ormization of the United States Steel corporation. Presumably it represents the disposition of E. C. Converse to take up a new vocation for him, that of a banker. He had gained a very large fortune when the United States Steel corporation was organized, because that organization took over as a subsidiary the C. M. & St P. tube manufacturing industry with which Mr. Converse's name and di-

rection had been associated most rection had been associated most invorably.

Some of the New York bankers of the older generation were doubtful about the expediency of organizing a new national bank. But Mr. Converse and those who were associated with him did not undertake this new banking plan in the fog. They knew where they could get business. They were able to call to their assistance several young men who had already fixed attention upon themselves by reason of their efficiency and wise originality and foresight while serving in subordinate banking positions. In that way Henry P. Davison, then just begining his career, was brought to the Liberty bank and it was brought to the Liberty bank and it was his association with that bank which inspired in him the project which resulted in The Bankers Trust institution.
