Increased Light
Rates Are Denied
By City Council
Commissioner Ure Introduces
Ordinance Proposing Bond
Issues of \$250,000 for
Municipal Plant.

The city council, by unanimous
vote yesterday, denied the applica-
tion of the Nebraska Power
company for an increase in rates.
Hearing on this application have
been going on before the council for
several weeks.

Commissioner W. G. Ure introduced
an ordinance providing for
submission to the voters at the com-
ing election, May 3, of a proposition
to issue \$250,000 bonds to make a
start on a municipal electric light
and power plant in connection with
the Florence pumping station.

The council ordered taken from the
files three ordinances which have
been there for 18 months. These
ordinances, Mr. Ure said, are to be
considered with a view of reducing
the initial rate from 6 to 5 cents
and raising rates of large consum-
ers.

J. E. Davidson, general manager
of the Nebraska Power company,
and J. A. C. Kennedy, attorney for
the company, were present when the
council's decision was announced.
Mr. Kennedy said the company has
no present intention of carrying its
case into the courts.

Mayor Smith read a 12-page, type-
written decision of the council's find-
ings, embracing a brief history of the
recent hearings.

The council found, the statement
said, that the company's revenues
under its present rates are sufficient
to enable it to earn a fair return on
the fair value of all its properties
devoted to public service and to set
aside annually a sufficient deprecia-
tion reserve.
