

Employes of United States Corporation to Share in Earnings of Over \$100,000,000.

hicago Tribune-Omaha Bee Leased Wire Sharon, Pa., March 30 .- Announcement of a profit-sharing plan to employes of United States Steel Corporation plants here has been made The basis of the bonus to be given the men is as follows: On profits from \$100,000,000 to \$150,000,000, a bonus of 2 per cent will be paid; to \$200,000,000, 234 per

cent and in excess of this amount 21/2 per cent will be distributed. Instead of limiting the distribution of a percentage of earnings over a certain sum to "men who occupy official and semi-official positions and who are engaged in directing and managing the affairs of the corporation and its several subsidiary companies," as formerly, the new plan provides that "any employe of the corporation or of its subsidiaries and any person actively engaged in the conduct of its or their business, who hall have been in the regular and ontinuous employment of the corporation or of its subsidiaries, or vho has been actually engaged in he conduct of its or their business of the term of one year or more and who, by his ability, industry and loyalty has, in the judgment of the ommittee appointed, rendered servces which have contributed in an musual degree to the success of the corporation, shall be entitled to

share in the distribution of the fund. The election of a committee of hree stockholders at the annual meeting of the corporation is proided for, and this committee, beides being charged with the determining of the distribution of the fund, is also empowered to distribute t wholly in cash or partly in United
