Europe's Straits In Fixing Tariff Conditions in Germany Even

Worse Than Pictured, Declares Swedish Expert On Visit to N. Y.

BY HOLLAND.

Axel Wahlberg, who in Sweden, which is his home, has gained a high reputation as an engineer and metallurgist, is now in the United States and has brought information respecting conditions, especially those which are to be found in Germany, which he has imparted to some of the business men of New York. Mr. Wahlberg does not bring as encouraging reports as others have recently brought from Europe. His point of view, however, is that of a man of science and as an engineer of long experience. He looks at the situation not from the political, but from the purely practical point of view. He has had opportunity to become familiar not only with affairs in Germany, but to some extent with the

situation in Russia. Mr. Wahlberg believes that Germany is in a much more desperate economic and industrial condition than others have asserted to be the fact. Germany's situation is so desperate in his view that Europe is now -and by and by the rest of the world will be-harmfully affected by it. If Germany was not situated in the heart of Europe the depressing influences might not be so great. Germany, however, can recover, but she must be aided to that recovery and must not be economically op-

presseil: Conditions in Russia. Russia, Mr. Wahlberg says, is even in a worse condition than Germany. He gathered some statistics when he was in Russia recently and these show, he says, that two-thirds of all the horses that were in Russia before the bolshevists gained control are now gone. Only one-third of the entire number of horses as compared with four years ago are now available for industry. The loss of cows has been greater. Not more than one-quarter of the cows which Russia possessed before the revolution are now alive and unless the destruc-

tion of cattle for food is ended the time is not distant when Russia will have no dairy cattle or oxen.

Almost all of the sheep are gone and a country which formerly raised much of the food for Europe can now with difficulty feed itself. In this information may be discovered one of the reasons why Lenine has announced a change of policy and is sucking to establish trade relations with other nations and is also inviting capital into Russia. But the wonder is, according to Mr. Wahlberg, what Russia can offer in the way of trade. It can produce not enough for its immediate needs. It has a good deal of gold and might make use of that in trade relations with other countries.

Real Ffects in U. S.

In Russia and also in central and south-eastern Europe the laboring man who has more than one shirt is an exception. Everybody is under-nourished. One estimate is that \$350,006,000 people who as a whole constitute about one-half of the winter poundation of the world are so reduced in circumstances that their purchases are limited to the barest necessaries of life. Russia, Austria, Poland, Cacho-Slovakia, Jugo-Slavia, Germany, Italy are buying less per capita than at any time since the lattle of Waterion.

We are beginning to feel in the United States the unfavorable effect of this loss in buying capacity of much of the rest of the world. South America and the Far East are passing through an experience similar to the one which has been demonstrated by the considerable falling off in our own foreign trade.
