The directions call for dilution with an equal amount of water, but at least half again as much of the thick vegetable water can be used, making the resulting product more nutritious, more palatable and capable of serving more persons.

Baked rice croquettes are easier to prepare than the ordinary fried kind, are more healthful and afford a pleasing change in the menu. They are especially good made of scraps of ham or tongue, but beef, lamb or veal may also be used. To make, run the meat through a food chopper. Boil rice and add when about half cooked, salt, paprika, chopped parsiey, onion and chopped celery. Boil until all the liquid is absorbed. The rice should be fairly sticky in that the croquettes consistency so that the croquettes will keep their shape. Add the chopped meat, shape like croquettes and bake in a brisk oven in a well-greased baking pan. Put about a quarter teaspoonful of bacon fat on each croquette. They will not need to be turned or basted, and in about 20 minutes or a half hour will have a crisp, brown coating all over and be ready to serve, garnished with parsley and small balls of current or tranberry jelly.


