The work which the college of agriculture is doing out in the state to promote more profitable farming is set forth in a recent annual report of the college's extension service.

There are now 44 county agricultural agents, five county home agents, and four county boys and girls club agents.

The extension specialists last year spent a total of 1,709 days out in the counties assisting in this educational work.

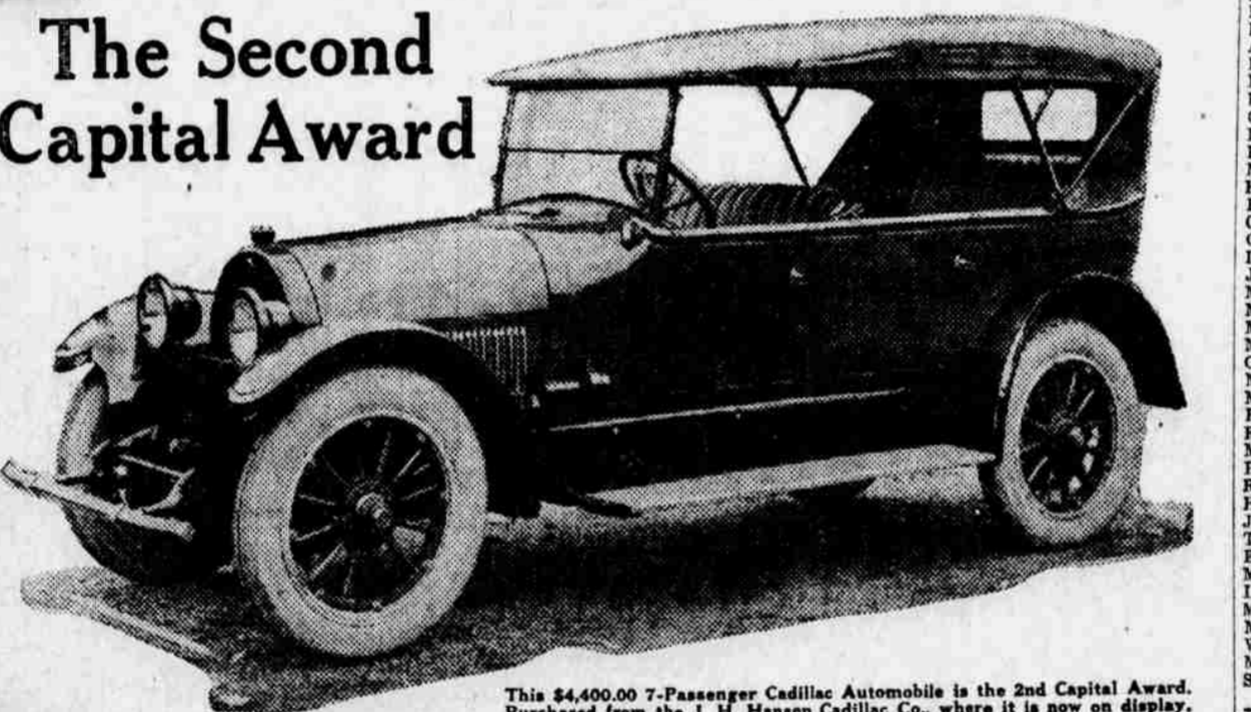
