> Australian Firm's Preference For Drafts on English Mctropolis Example of Tendency in Many Nations.

By HOLLAND. An American importer having oc-

casion to buy Australian commodities in considerable amount sought

recently to obtain the necessary banking facilities with which to pay for these commodities. He carried a considerable balance in one of the New York City banks. He asked for certain credit facilities not exceeding in amount what his balance would justify. He found that the bankers were willing to give him these facilities, but when he said that he wanted London drafts running four months with which to make payments, the bankers declined to grant his request. He said, however, that unless he obtained drafts on London he could not buy the goods in Australia. In that country they insisted upon London drafts, not looking with any favor upon drafts upon New York.

He was told by the bankers that if that was the case it would be the better part for him to concel his Australian order. There was no good reason why drafts on New York should not be as acceptable as drafts upon London, or why London in-stead of New York should receive the commission for transactions of this character. As it was necessary for him to obtain these commodities, he at last accepted New York drafts and these were not declined by Australia when it was learned there that these drafts must be accepted
