

**Prominent Colorado Mining Man Dies on Journey to Honolulu**

Denver, June 1.—Henry Roger Wolcott, Colorado pioneer mining

man, civil war veteran and philanthropist, died Tuesday in Honolulu, according to a cable received here. He was 75 years old and unmarried. Born in Longmeadow, Mass., March 15, 1846, Mr. Wolcott began life as a bank clerk in Cleveland, resigning to enlist in the Cleveland regiment in the civil war. After the

war he began a commercial business career in Springfield, Mass., later going to Chicago and then transferred his interests to the then booming west, coming to Colorado in 1869 to engage in mining. For many years he was a director of the Equitable Life Insurance company of New York and was promi-

nent in club circles of Denver, New York, Boston and Washington. Mr. Wolcott has a sister, Miss Clara Gertrude Wolcott, in Boston and a brother, Herbert Walker Wolcott, in Buffalo. Commercial vehicles in England are paying nearly one-half the motor taxation of that country.

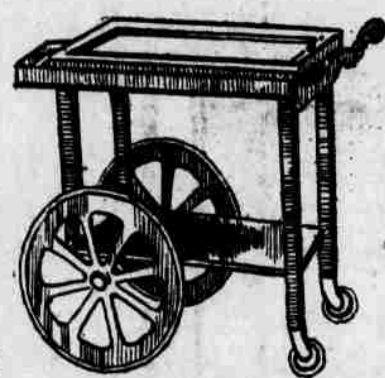

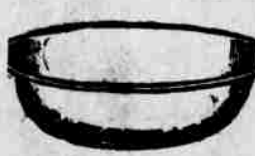

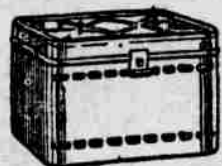
