GEE BUT YOU'RE HEAVY DOGGIE- I'LL DOCTOR YOU ALL UP-



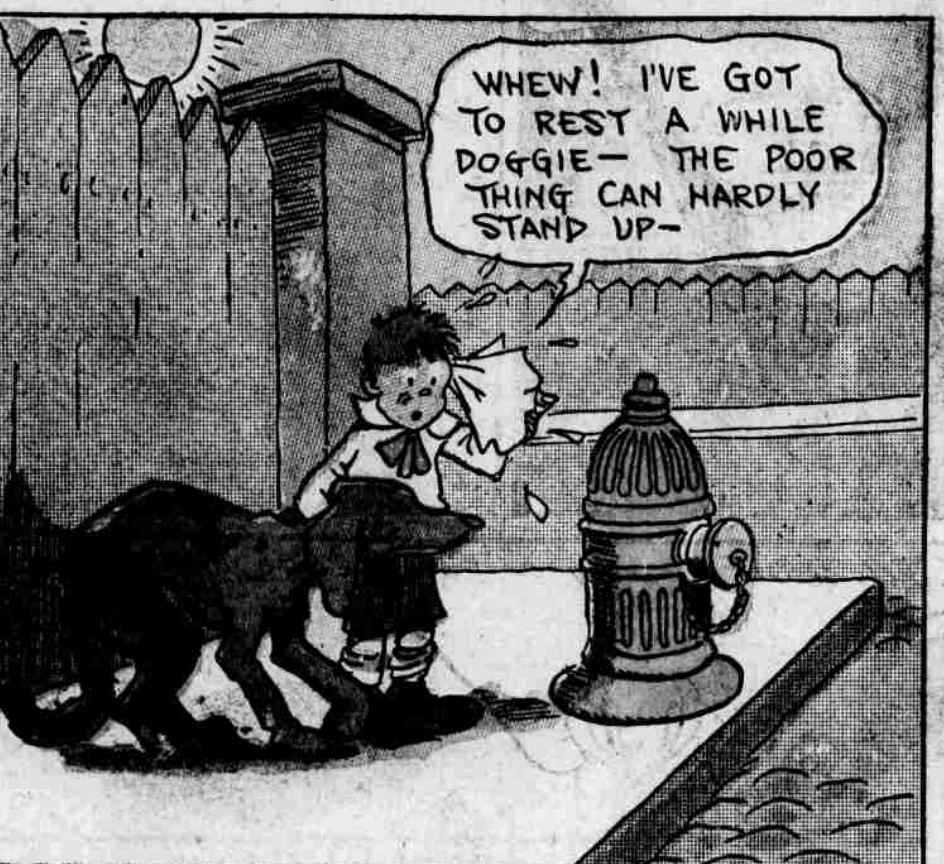
JUST COME WITH ME- I'LL BET NOBODY'LL EVER ABUSE YOU ANY MORE-

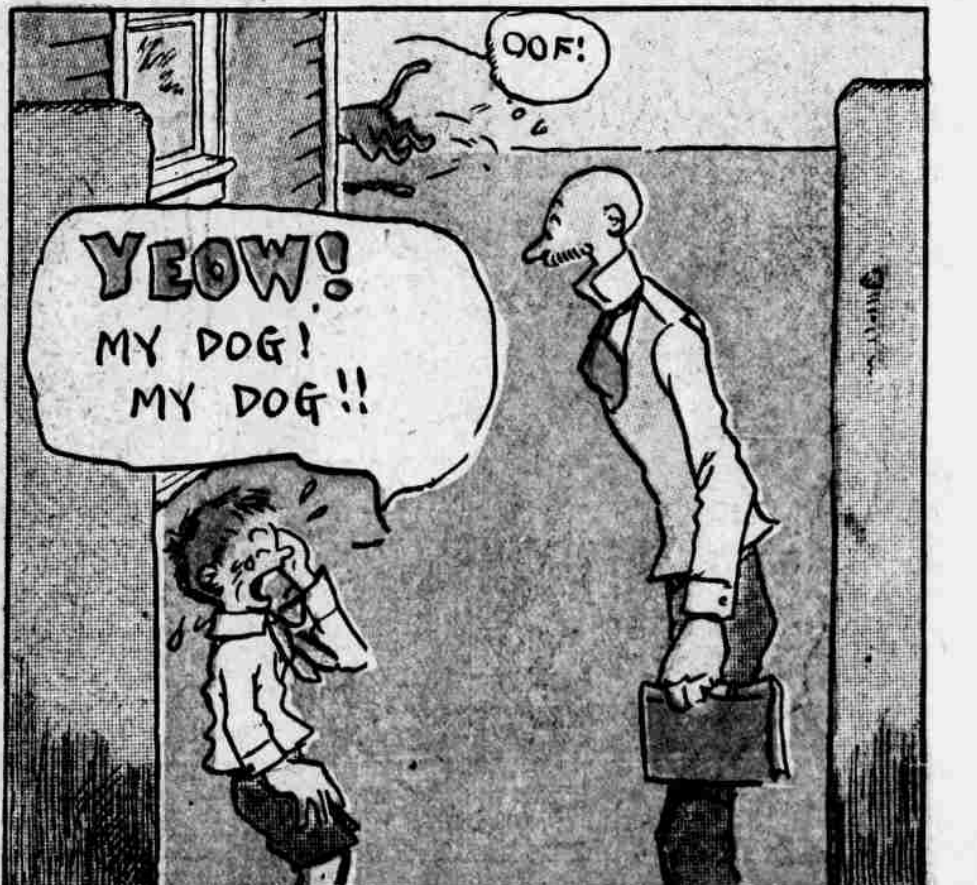

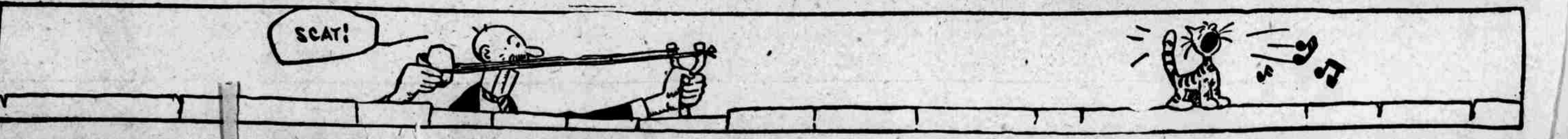
