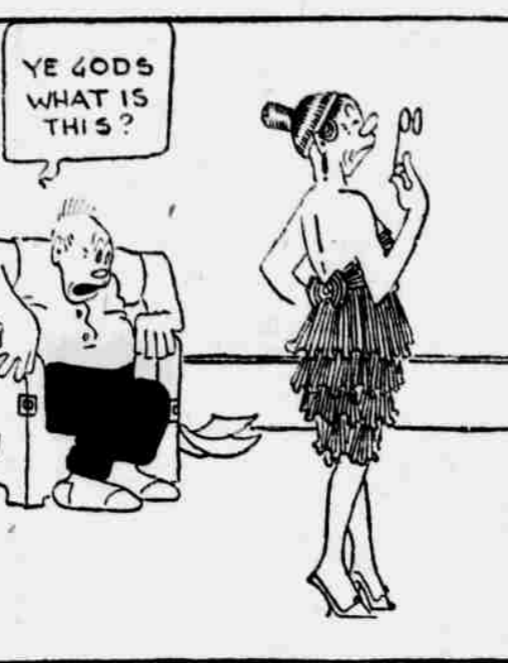

Anarchists Plan Big Convention During September

Reds Resume Operations in U. S. on Large Scale—Union of Russian Toilers Most Dangerous.

New York, Aug. 22.—When the Buford set sail for Russia with Alex Berkman and Emma Goldman on board, never to return, Americans believed anarchism in the United States had been dealt a lasting blow. Goldman and Berkman were the chief spokesmen of violent thought in this country.

For a time there was not much doing in anarchistic circles and then came the Wall street explosion, in which 39 innocent persons were blown to fragments. That was formal notice to the United States that the bolsheviks had resumed operations.

It was learned Sunday that all groups of anarchists, bolsheviks and agents of force of all nationalities will hold a convention in September, presumably in New York City or somewhere in New Jersey. Daily News Monday will publish additional data, showing the communist party in America is now a nation-wide revolutionary organization, with the open and avowed purpose of overthrowing the United States government by violence and putting in its place a soviet government.

In Cleveland the anarchists are mostly Russians and in Chicago the Italians and Russians control the situation. By far the most dangerous group in New York today is the re-organized union of Russian workers, now known as the Union of Russian Toilers. They are anarcho-communists and two years ago had a dues-paying membership of 7,000 in the United States. Presumably this membership has greatly increased in recent months. In the Department of Justice raids of 1919 several leaders of this organization were arrested and deported.

Working hand in hand with the Galleani group, the Spanish Propensia group and the Union of Russian Toilers, are the I. W. W. who have recently murdered men in the west for refusing to join them. The I. W. W. advocates the general strike and sabotage as a means of destroying capital and seizing the government. It is working chiefly among foreign miners, in the railroad switch yards and in western labor unions.

It is the announced purpose of all these groups, and more especially the I. W. W., to destroy the American Federation of Labor. This end is secured membership in the federation and are "bor-ing from within." These are the persons responsible for violence and sabotage in strikes, but the labor unions get the blame for the destruction.

Deviis Lake Sheriff Seeks Alleged Omaha Holdup Men Sheriff Edward Elliott of Devils Lake, N. D., is another person who wants to put his fingers on Tom Kelly and Will Connolly, alias Tom Maher, both of Omaha. In a letter to Chief of Detectives Wm. Deussen, Elliott stated he is positive Kelly and Maher are the bandits who held up two banks in a small town near Devils Lake two months ago.

Federal authorities and Omaha police have been searching for Kelly, who is wanted for swindling Canadian whisky men out of thousands of dollars. The wholesale value of motor vehicles manufactured last year was \$2,250,000,000, with \$1,000,000,000 in the parts and accessories lines.

WHY—Is a Person's Family Tree Called Their Pedigree?

When we speak of a person's "pedigree," or even of the pedigree of a dog or horse, we do not, at least consciously, mean to infer that this has anything in common with the foot of a crane. But this happens to be the literal meaning of the word which, like a number of others, has found its way into English because of the difficulty in applying the proper pronunciation to a French phrase. "Pedigree" is, of course, nothing more than a family tree of a list of ancestors and this, when blocked out in the chart form so dear to the hearts of genealogists, takes the form of connecting lines radiating from the common progenitor of the family to his descendants. The French, always fond of painting word-pictures of familiar objects, referred to a chart of this nature as a pied-de-grue or crane's foot, on account of the resemblance between the two.
