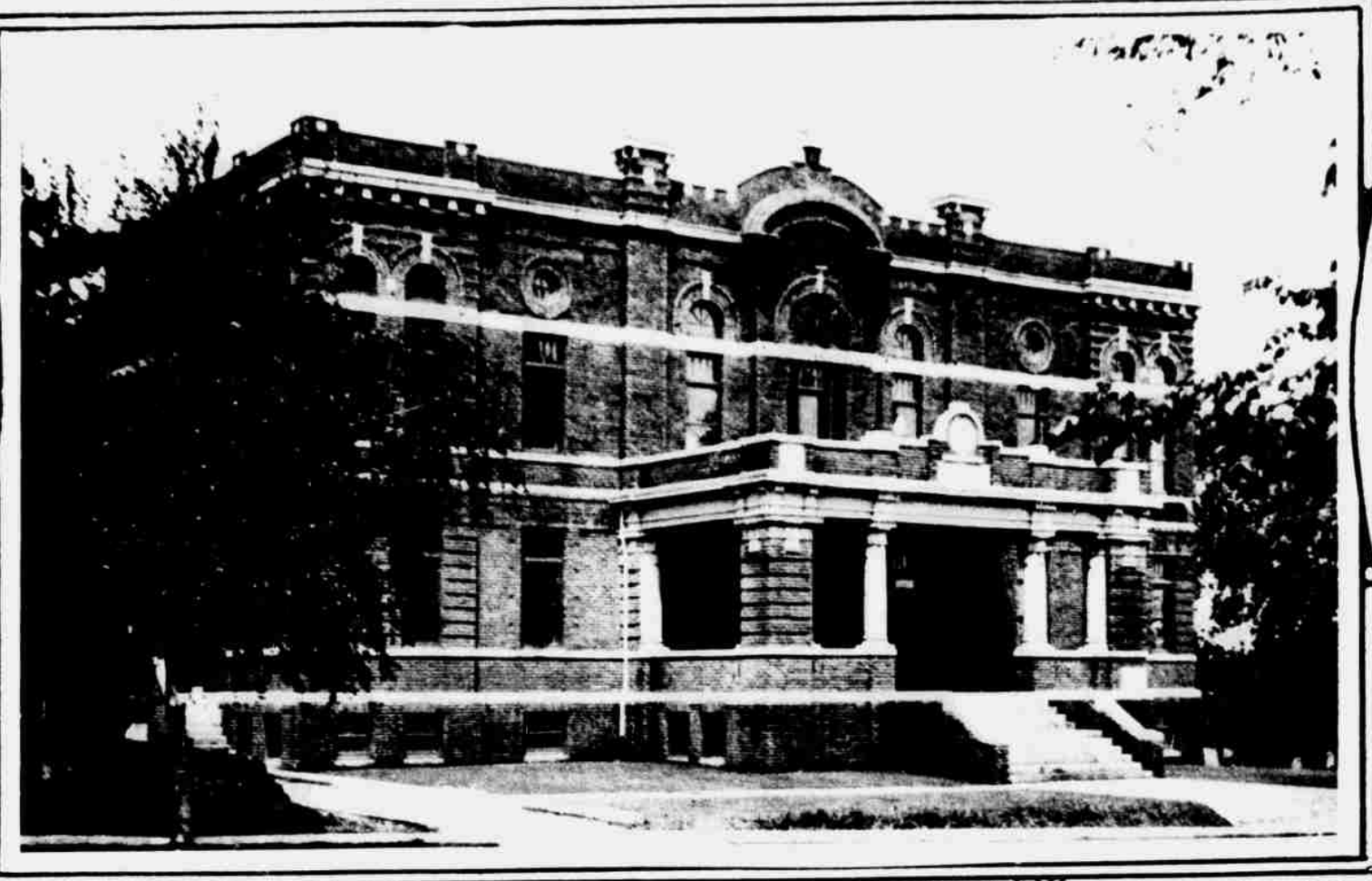

Another of the Bee Series Showing Scenes and People of Iowa and Nebraska Cities



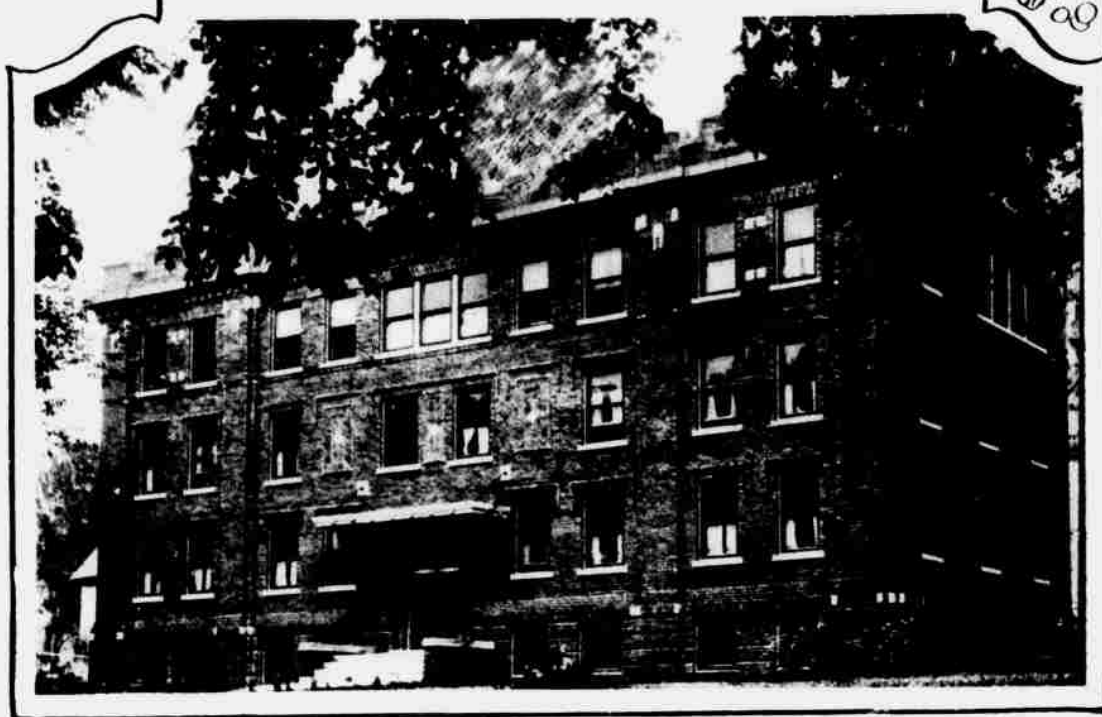

The Atlantic Hospital owned by local physicians



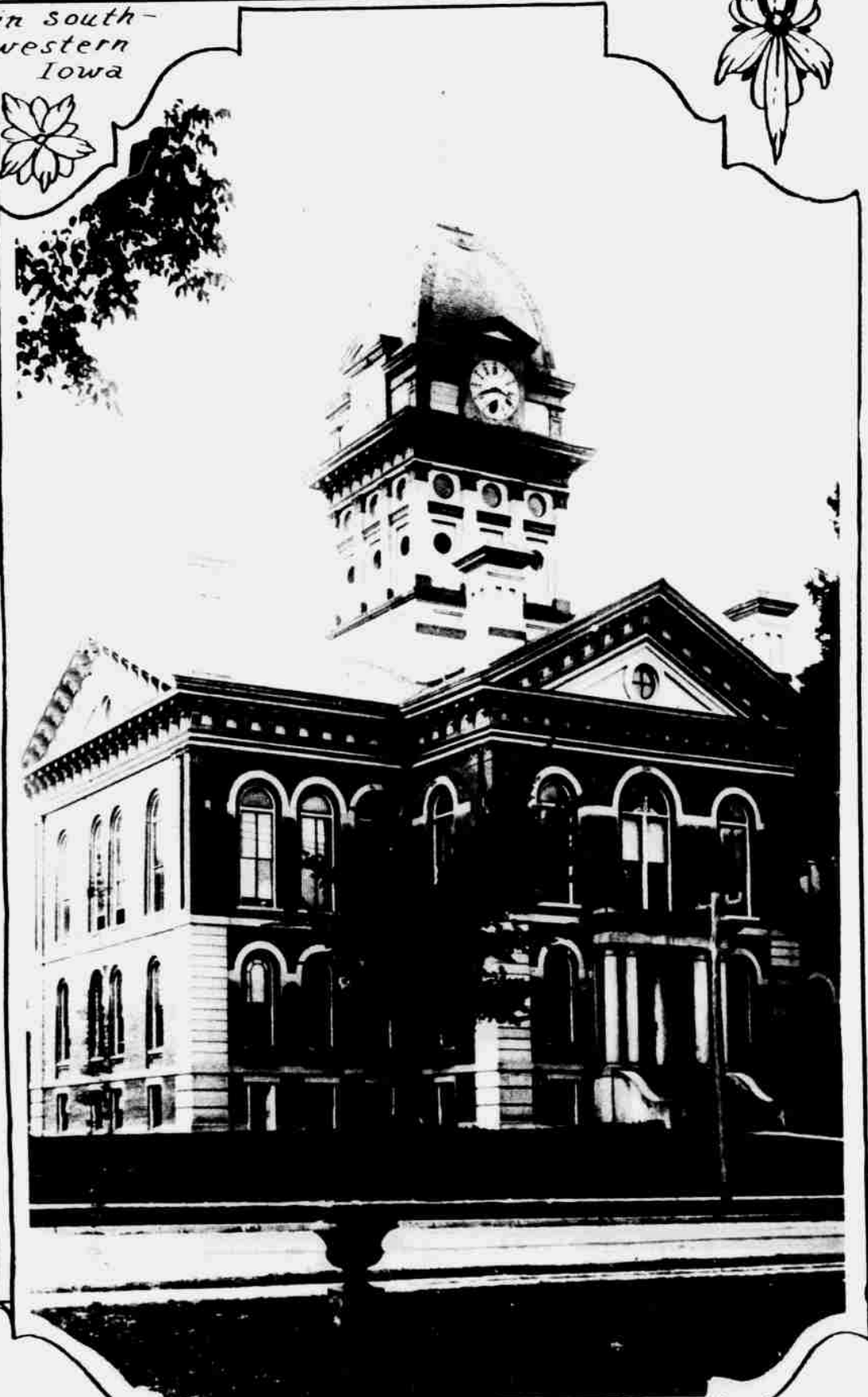
Atlantic boasts the largest garage in south-western Iowa



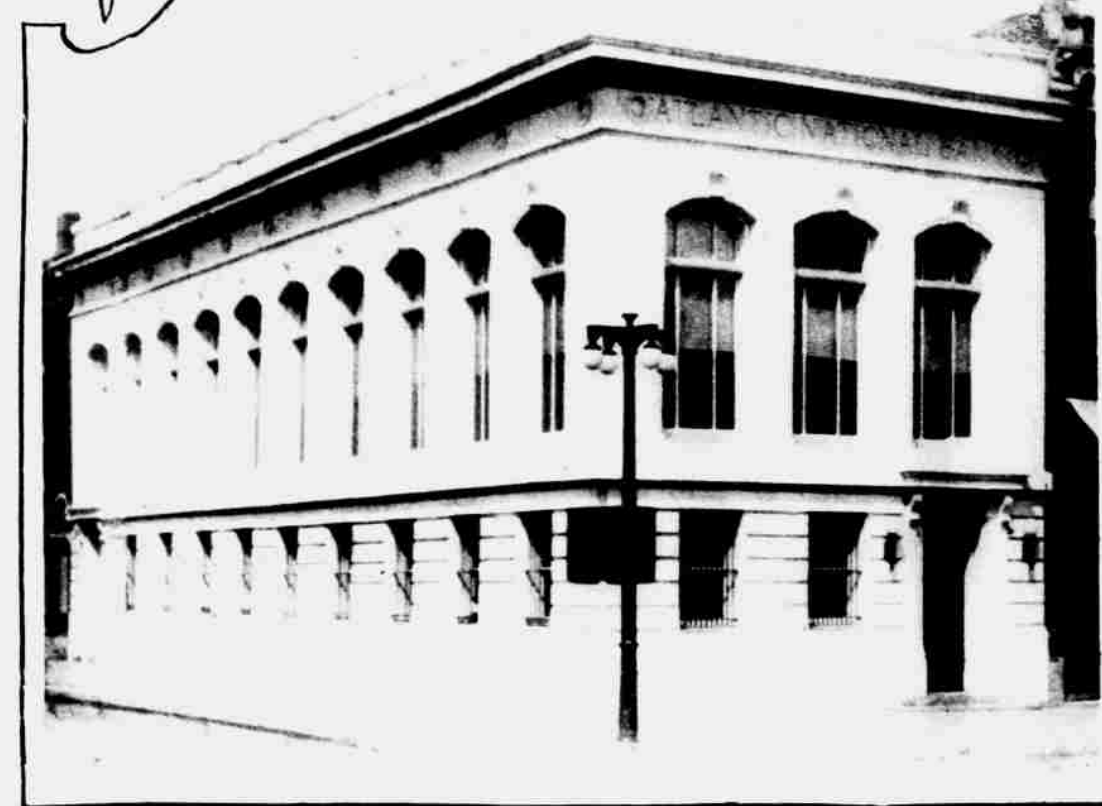
