

Unemployed of **London Demand** Increased Aid

Idle Men Receiving Reliet Ask Municipalities for Equivalent to Full Time Working Wages.

By The Associated Press.

London, Sept. 1 .- London municipalities are facing new and different social problems through the demands being made by the unemployed in various working class districts such as Woolwich and Poplar, where there are labor majorities on the local boards. The present demands insist that instead of the small amounts ordinarily paid by the boards of guardians for what is known as outdoor poor relief-8 to 12 shillings for a man and 4 to 6 shillings for each child, where the man is unemployed an amount virtually equivalent to what the man would receive for his full working time shall be paid for himself, wife and children.

As in some districts, there are from 20,000 to 30,000 unemployed, and at the end of July in addition to more than 54,000 inmates of work-houses and infirmaries, there were over 132,000 persons receiving outdoor relief, it would be impossible for the municipalities to pay such demands without an enormous addition to the burden of rates.




