

Smoot Favors Entirely New Taxation Plan

Sales Levy Measure Prepared By Utah Senator in Line With Some of Otto H. Kahn's Suggestions.

Senator Smoot, United States senator from Utah, has gained high reputation among the leaders in the financial district and his reputation is likely to be enhanced by the senator's latest expression of his ability in the field of taxation and economics.

Senator Smoot's tentative bill contains only a few tax paragraphs. Each one of them is easily understood and the promulgation of the bill, collection of taxes if the senator's recommendations in whole or in part be adopted will be made as early as possible.

Recent Tax Law Harmful.

The senator is known to be a profound student of economic questions and his financial legislation is in line with the public opinion. It is observed that the tax law passed in 1918 is in sympathy with some of the suggestions which have been made by Otto H. Kahn, eminent in financial circles.

Business Men Favor Sales Tax.

Probably Senator Smoot has heard from business men that a sales tax is the only way to raise money for the government. Almost all of them favor a sales tax, and many of them have in mind when they speak of a sales tax, not a tax on the sale of goods, but a tax on the sale of services.

Views of Mr. Kahn.

Mr. Kahn's recommendations are an easy to understand as are the general principles upon which Senator Smoot has formulated his bill. He believes the early collection of a sales tax is the best way to raise money for the government.
