

### Shortage of 683 School Teachers In 59 Counties

Surplus of 193 in 23 Counties Reported to State Superintendent—West Is Hard Hit.

Lincoln, Sept. 14.—(Special.)—There is a net shortage of 683 rural teachers and 50 high school teachers in Nebraska, according to a statement given out today by State Superintendent John M. Matzen.

In 23 of the 93 counties of the state, there is a surplus of 193 teachers, Mr. Matzen's statement shows. Douglas county is included in this list with 10 additional rural teachers and 10 surplus grade teachers.

Fifty-nine of the 93 counties report a shortage of 683 teachers, the greatest scarcity of instructors being in the following districts: Cherry county needs 50 rural teachers; Custer, 35; Garden, 30; Keya Paha, 30; Lincoln, 30; Sioux, 20; Red Willow, 25; Chase, 20; Brown, 20; Hitchcock, 20; Dawson, 25; and Dawes, McPherson, Sheridan and Sherman, 15 each.

**Employment for All.**  
The state superintendent's office is sending out letters to all of the county superintendents of the state, showing the exact status of the teaching forces in each county of the state, and in this way it is hoped to assign surplus teachers in the 23 counties to districts where a vacancy exists.

These counties report they have enough teachers but that no surplus exists.

### Former Bootlegger Is Removed From Police Force at Fremont

Fremont, Neb., Sept. 14.—(Special.)—Tom Hooper, member of the Fremont police department since last spring, was discharged from the force for alleged breaches of discipline, connected with a booze party which came to grief in Fremont a few nights ago. M. Krause, Antonio Felix and Fritz Buchholtz, all of Morse Bluff, Neb., and Clarence Morgan of Fremont, were arrested in a restaurant on the charge of creating a disturbance. A quantity of booze was found in their possession for which M. Krause, owner of the car in which the liquor was found, was fined \$100.

The officer's discharge follows on the heels of the arrest of these men. Hooper was placed on the department by Mayor Green, shortly after he had been released from jail after serving three months on the charge of bootlegging. Much wrath was stirred up with the appointment of Hooper as a cop but Mayor Green and Sheriff Condit explained their actions stating that the returned alleged bootlegger would aid in the discovery of other traffickers in liquor.

### Ice Dealers at Fremont Reduce Price \$2 a Ton

Fremont, Neb., Sept. 14.—(Special.)—Price of ice fell in Fremont from \$8 to \$6 a ton as a result of the cold weather. The drop in temperature, they stated, will eliminate danger of waste and loss caused by the oppressive heat suffered during the summer. They believe the cool nights of the future will allow the price of ice to remain at the reduced figure.

### Manufacturers Outline Plans For Next Year

Research and Investigation of Problems of Nebraska Retailers Will Be One of Principal Duties.

Lincoln, Sept. 14.—(Special.)—The executive committee of the Nebraska Manufacturers' association, meeting here today, mapped out the work of the organization for 1921-22. The program includes the following activities:

Educational activities and service to the public.

To give the general public an appreciation of the problems of retail merchandising, to foster a spirit of co-operation and mutual service among the merchants.

Research and investigation to compile statistical data on various problems of the Nebraska retailer; to tabulate and interpret such data and to publish the results.

Provide local merchants' institutes and club meetings.

The association also plans to provide special services to members of the organization, including personal correspondence, auditing freight bills, and collecting accounts.

The members went on record for national and state legislation of wholesale laws. The committee also favored mutual fire insurance to enable the members to carry their insurance on mercantile buildings, stocks, dwellings, and household goods at a minimum cost.

The executive committee was of

the opinion that the research work should be enlarged.

### Hall County Red Cross Sends Shipment to Europe

Grand Island, Neb., Sept. 14.—(Special.)—The Hall county chapter of the Red Cross, shipped out 3,210 pieces of wearing apparel for the babies, children and women of Europe, among them being a large number of infants layettes numbering 1,000 pieces. The Red Cross quota for the chapter was 2,948. Many of these garments were made over though some were newly knitted or made and of the finest, newest material. The shipment went to Brooklyn, N. Y., whence it will go direct to the Red Cross in Europe.

### Beatrice Pastor Declines Offer of Detroit Church

Beatrice, Neb., Sept. 14.—(Special.)—Rev. J. Franklin Haas, pastor of Centenary Methodist Episcopal church, has declined an offer to become pastor of the Highland Park church, Detroit, and the board of trustees of the church here have unanimously requested the conference to return Dr. Haas to Beatrice.

### Beatrice Will Condemn Lots to Build City Park

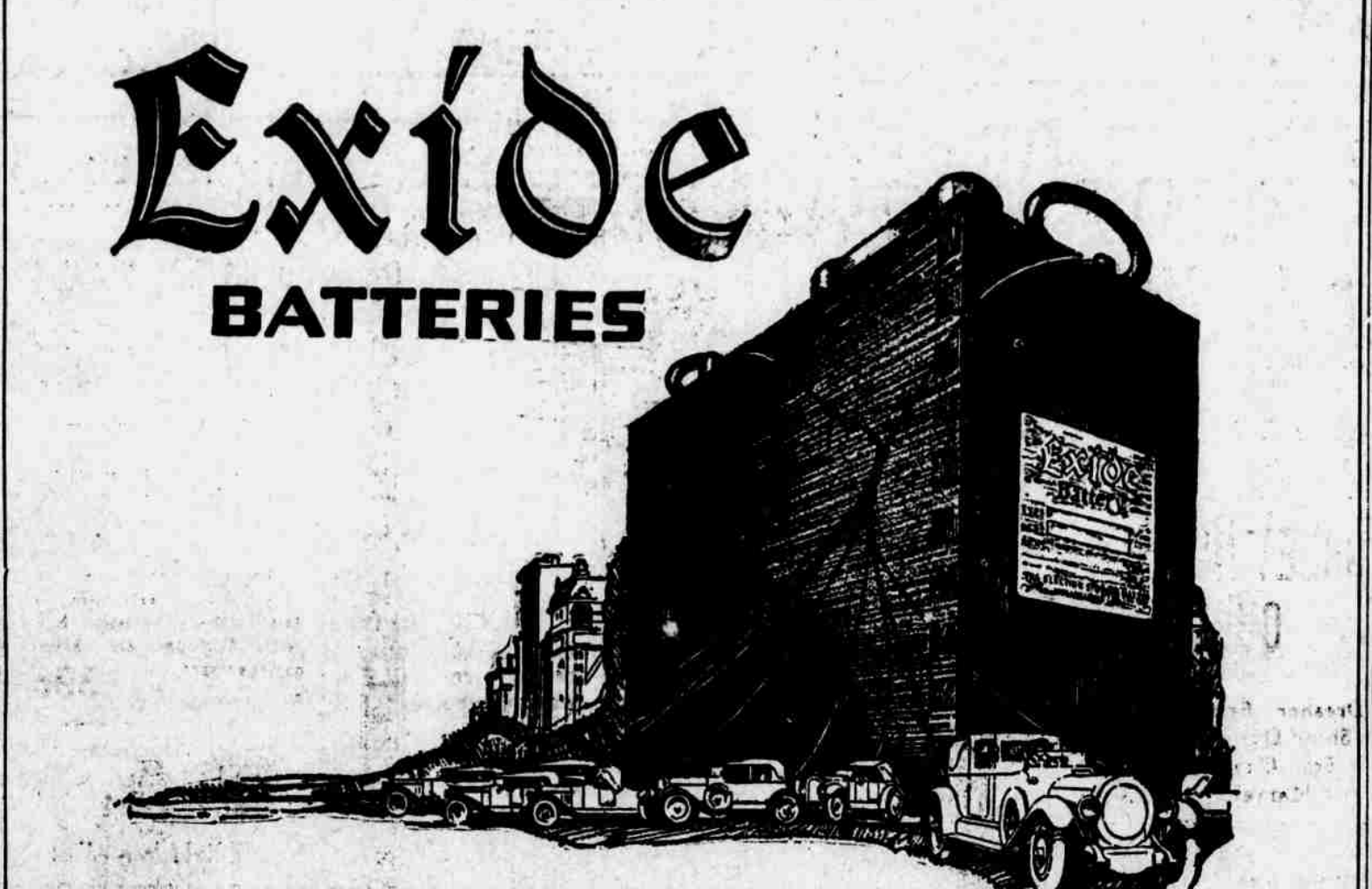
