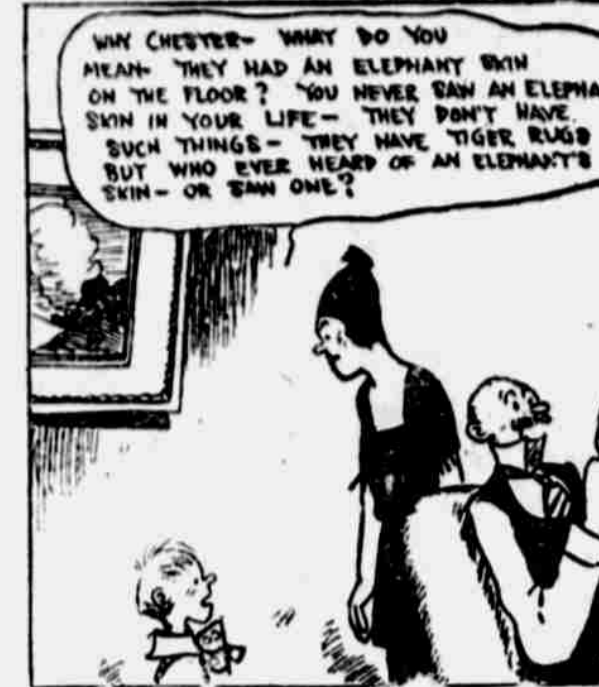


Big Iron Mine in Mexico Worked By U.S. Capital

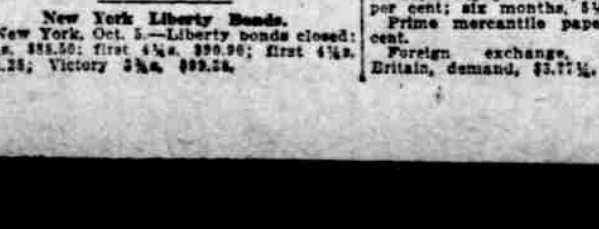

Some cattle men, he said, have mortgaged their ranches to buy steers and their losses will nearly bankrupt them. He said bankers are not able to relieve the situation by advancing more money.
