State, Prediction

R. Baker and G. L. Hagge of the Grand Island plant of the American Sugar Beet company encouraged and furthered local interest in the future of beet raising in Dawson county. Baker, who spoke first and has represented his company in Dawson county for some years, said that the beets grown in the county for the last few years were of a high average although alkali, in places, was a handicap. He stated, however, that the coming irrigation project would do away with this evil and prepare the lower Platte valley for the great-est beet-producing territory in the

Farmers Are Shy.

He also gave his opinion that the reason comparatively few beets are grown in Dawson county at the present, is not that attempts have been unsuccessful, but in the fact that local farmers know little or nothing of beet-culture and are therefore shy about trying it. He praised the local citizens for their attempts to overcome this shyness.

Hagge, field man of the Grand Island plant, the second speaker, went more into detail about various phases of beet growing along the valley, and above all warned the local enthusiasts to adopt the "slow and easy" policy. He advised that the local farmers, for the first year to plant only 10 or 15 acres of beets for an experiment and increase their acreage in proportion with their suc-

Must Have 8,000 Acres. As to the establishing of a factory in Dawson county Hagge stated that the farmers must first prove that they

can raise enough beets to maintain one, in other words, 8,000 acres. This year 1,100 acres was the county's quota, but in a few years. Hagge thinks, the government irrigation project, backed by various citizen bodies, will bring the beet production up to a point where a factory for the territory will be necessary. In the meantime, Hagge pledges the co-operation of his company with the local and other bodies in increasing the beet production of Dawson
