## State Laws Blamed By H. D. Lute for Lack Of Finances for Farmers

Lincoln, Dec. 1 .- (Special Telegram.)-Statements made at conferences on farm aid that it was the fault of the Nebraska farmers, them-selves, if they didn't obtain the same proportion of war finance money as other states, called for a sharp re-buke from H. D. Lute, secretary of the Nebraska Farm Bureau federa-

Lute declared it was the result of Nebraska laws which made certain restrictions and limitations that delayed the Nebraska farmer in taking layed the Nebraska farmer in taking advantage of the government's aid. The leniency of Attorney General Charence A. Davis and J. E. Hart, secretary of the department of trade and commerce, has overcome this difficulty, he declared.
