

Household Hints

Perfume burners are liked by many women who do not personally use perfume. They like the scent of perfume in their rooms, and sometimes prefer a floral scent to one of incense. These burners are little porcelain lamps, with a cup-shaped depression over the electric bulb to accommodate a few drops of perfume. The gentle heat of the bulb vaporizes the perfume, forcing off its scent in a charming way. The tiny lamps are decorative, aside from being useful.

An interesting parchment lampshade is stained a soft, light brown. On it is then painted a fruit design in sepia. On the inside of the shade the same design is painted in the natural colors of the fruit, quite bright and clear. When the light is off there is a very sedate-looking shade in soft light brown with a sepia design. When the light is turned on there is a lighter brown shade with the softest sort of coloring in a fruit design—soft purple grapes, soft, red and yellow apples, and softer green leaves. This is another trick worth copying.
