This statement conveyed the information that the gold cover for federal reserve notes in circulation after setting aside 35 per cent against deposit liabilities was somewhat in excess of 100 cents to the dollar.

This is far in excess of the gold which is held permanently in the Federal Reserve treasury as the basis for the legal tender or greenbacks. And the greenback is regarded as the most solid asset of the government and possibly even better than a bank of England note.

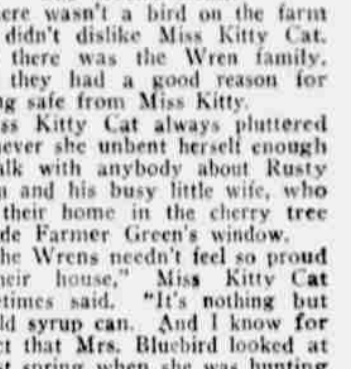
