

Buyers of Stolen Clothing Fined

Youth Held for Store Thefts Says Purchasers Encouraged Him.

Buyers of stolen clothing, rather than the youthful thief, were fined by Judge Foster in police court yesterday when Eunash Doxie, 18, 602 North Twenty-third street, Commerce High school student, was tried for petit larceny.

Doxie admitted he had been stealing clothing from the Brandeis store since Christmas and accused Mr. and Mrs. H. Williams, Dillon hotel, and Anna Hawthorne, manicure, 1821 Leavenworth street, of buying the

goods and encouraging him to get more. "Doxie was directed by one questionable character to another in the underworld and encouraged to steal more," said William Garnett, detective. Judge Foster fined the Williams couple \$30 and costs each and the Hawthorne girl \$25 and costs. The case against the Doxie boy was taken under advisement. Relatives of the Doxie boy blamed pool halls and bad company for his deeds. "He's been stealing to pay his doctor bill," Detective Garnett testified. Larry Boylan, another student arrested with Doxie, was released to juvenile officers.
