

Formal Notice Received of Britson Reversal

Formal notice of the circuit court of appeals' action reversing, with costs, Federal Judge Woodruff's order for a receivership for the

Britson Tire Manufacturing company, was received Friday afternoon by Frank L. Weaver, Britson attorney. The communication does not state on what grounds the decision was reversed. Weaver wired for this additional information. Receiver Ralph West is required

to return all property in his hands to those from whom he received it. He is then to be discharged and the bill of complaint dismissed at the complainants' cost, the notice reads. West will be held on his \$50,000 bond for losses from sale of Britson property at prices alleged to be less than value, Weaver stated.

There can be no further action in the case until after the 60 days allowed by the circuit court for rehearing. A mandate will then be handed down. **Damato Hearing Deferred.** Hearing on a motion for a new trial for Mike Damato, convicted
