

Banks May Start Suit to Interpret Tax Law

At a special meeting of the Omaha Clearing House association yesterday afternoon the members decided that the organization will look to the state bank association for a clarification of certain features of the new state tax revenue law.

"Our association will take no separate action," said Ford Hovey, president, "but individual banks, being members of the Nebraska State Bankers' association, will naturally join in any action that the executive council of the state association will recommend. There is a possibility that a friendly suit by the state association may be brought to have the new tax law properly interpreted. There is a feeling that the law should tax capital and surplus instead of gross credits."

Omaha Ranks 37th City in Postal Savings Deposits

Omaha is 37th city in the United States in amount of postal savings deposits, according to a letter received by Postmaster Black yesterday from Washington. Total Omaha deposits are \$343,359. There are 120 cities in the country having more than \$100,000 deposits each. Total postal deposits on March 31 were \$144,500,000, a decrease of about \$500,000 in a month.

Bee Article on Forest Proposed for Schools

The attention of 2,800 pupils and 125 teachers of the Omaha Technical High school has been directed by D. E. Porter, principal, to an article which appeared in The Bee, April 2, on Nebraska's national forest.

Principal Porter wants the faculty and student body to read this article, in connection with the observance of the golden anniversary of Arbor day, April 22.

In a circular on the subject of the school, Mr. Porter requests that the history, spirit and significance of Arbor day be considered. He offers an outline of study. He believes that every pupil and teacher of his school, and of all the schools, should be familiar with the characteristics of trees.

Yellow Cab Company Asks Permit to Sell Securities
