

Georges Carpentier Scores "Ted" Lewis in First Round

World's Light-Heavyweight Champ Drives Sharp Right to Point of Englishman's Jaw For Victory

Frenchman Outweighs "Kid" Eighteen Pounds—Fans Hiss Winner—Bout Lasts Two Minutes and Fifteen Seconds.

London, May 11.—Georges Carpentier tonight knocked out Ted (Kid) Lewis in the first round of what has been called a 20-round bout for the light-heavyweight championship of the world, held by Carpentier.

The spectators were slow to realize that what occurred, but finally comprehended that the battle was over and Lewis was defeated, there arose a storm of boos and cries of "foul" from all parts of the vast audience, which drowned out the comparatively little applause Carpentier was receiving from his partisans.
