His up-to-date "Mephisto" is a aubtle fiend, with a marked inclination for diabolical jesta. Mr. Grifith sueceeds in making the character hideoualy sinuous and facile. fie is repulsive, aod yet he attracts and holds the attention. If there is anything devilish and demoniac in Goethe's great character that Mr. Grifith has not found and does not portray, we are not aware of it; and he has added a fow extra touches of his own.
