SEEN THROUGH THE CAMERA'S EYE

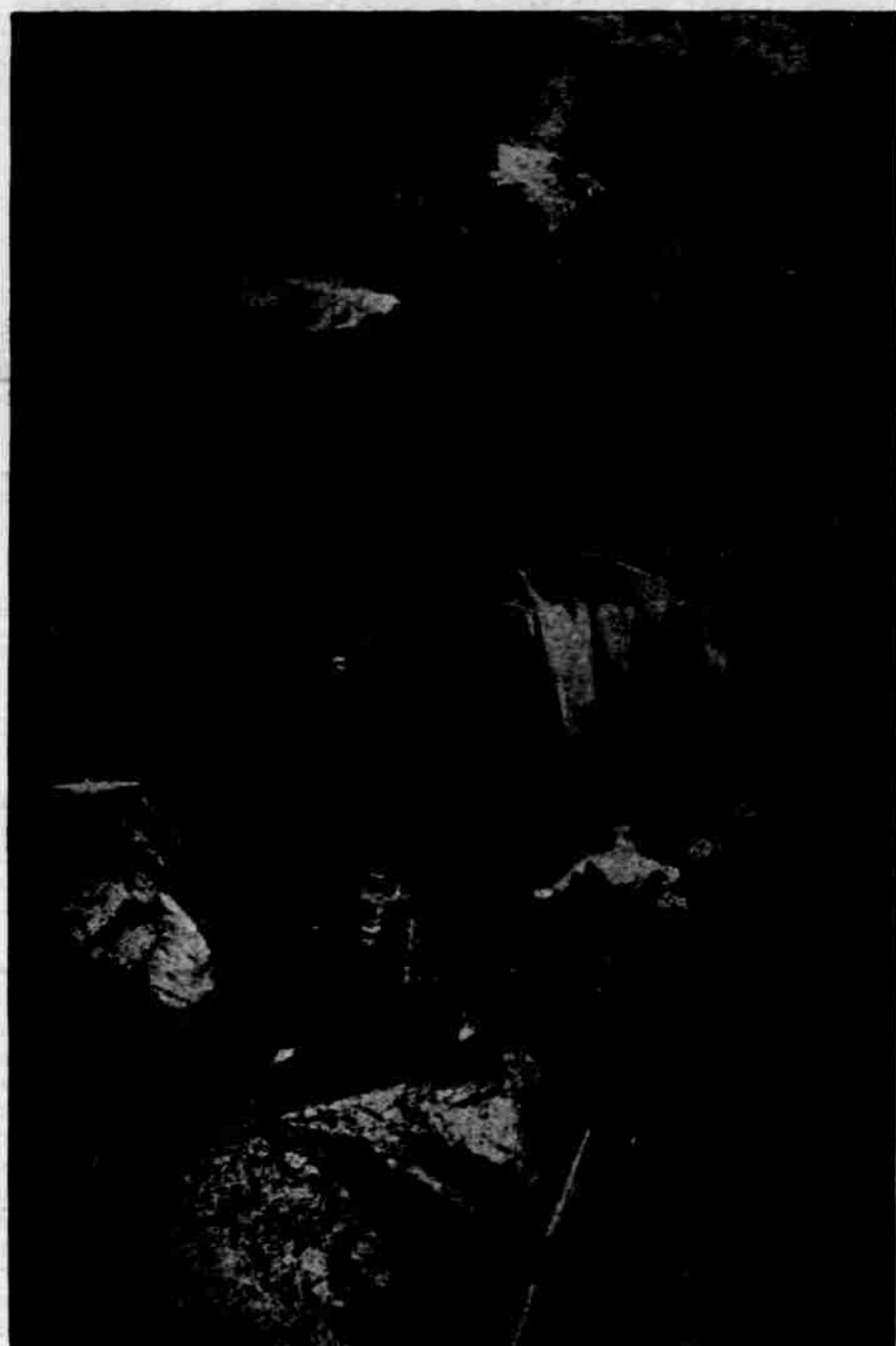
